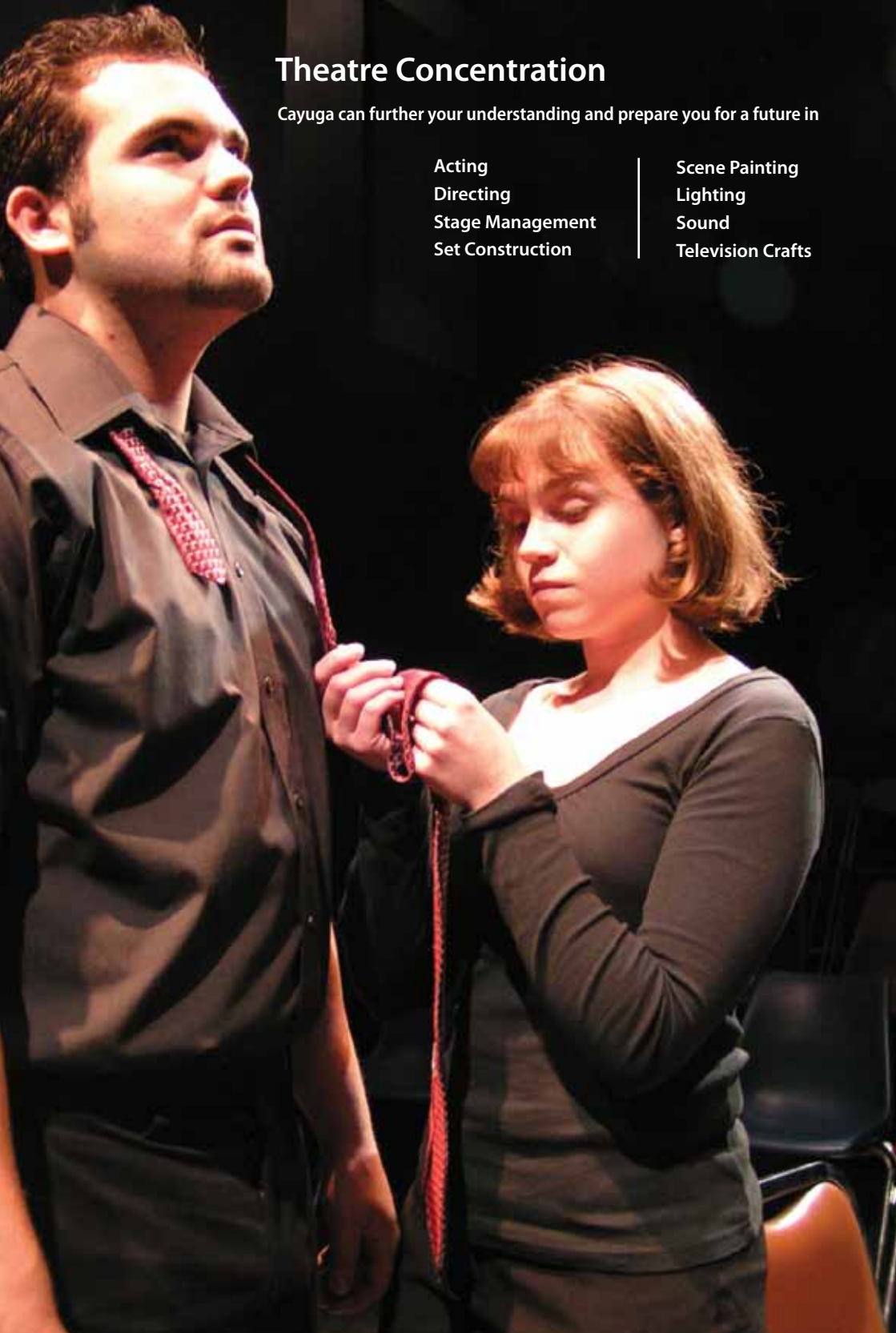

This concentration is designed for students who plan to transfer into theatre programs at four-year colleges and universities, students who wish to transfer as English majors or other liberal arts majors, and students who are interested in obtaining practice in working in theatre as actors, directors, and technicians.

Tradition of excellence

Cayuga's Harlequin Productions has received numerous awards for their work from both the American College Theatre Festival and the Theatre Association of NY State. Plus, Cayuga offers these special advantages:

- Transfer planning assistance available through Cayuga's Student Development office.



Facilities and Equipment:

Cayuga's newly renovated 424-seat Bisgrove Theatre features some of the latest technologies in lighting and sound equipment. Students will have instruction and hands-on access to all of this state-of-the-art gear, as well as a Black Box Theatre where students can experiment in an intimate environment as they learn their craft. Two 8-station dressing/make-up rooms and a modest scene shop complete the complex. On campus there is also a full working television studio where students can work in front of and behind the camera.

In touch with the industry

Students at Cayuga have received apprenticeships and work in varied environments such as: Merry-Go-Round Playhouse, Auburn Public Theatre, IATSE (stagehands union), Rock and Roll touring. Graduates of Cayuga can be found working for Disneyworld, Blue Man Group, Cirque du Soleil, Ice Capades, and various road-houses and tours.

Transfer opportunities

Cayuga graduates have successfully transferred to a wide variety of SUNY and private institutions to complete baccalaureate and graduate programs in their fields of interest. Special transfer agreements have been arranged with Wells and Le Moyne Colleges. Consult early with the Cayuga transfer counselor to assure maximum applicability of Cayuga course credit to your prospective upper-level school.
