BA in Sociology with Childhood/Special Education Teacher Certification

This unique program of study will allow you to seamlessly transfer up to 60 credits for a Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology, and become certified in childhood and special education, in just three and a half years. You will gain marketable skills and prepare yourself for a new career in either teaching or human services. An emphasis on liberal arts ensures that graduates will have the workplace characteristics that employers are seeking.

Affordable – Accessible – Convenient

Enjoy a program that is conveniently located and scheduled. It is ideal for individuals with professional and family responsibilities. You can complete the first three years of the program part-time at Cayuga. Courses will be taught on Sundays during the fall and spring semesters, and evenings during the summer. There may be an occasional on-line course offered. All courses will be taught by Le Moyne faculty members. Your last semester will be on a full-time basis, during which you will do your student teaching. There will also be an occasional seminar class at the Syracuse campus that

semester. You will benefit from the close collaboration between Le Moyne and Cayuga. Both institutions are noted for their strong student services.

Admission Requirements

Students need to work closely with a transfer counselor to be sure they take the required pre-requisites. An overall GPA of 2.6 is required for admission. High school transcripts and SAT/ACT scores will not be required. Students may apply to Le Moyne after they have completed 45 credits towards their associate degree. The priority application deadline is February first. Applications will be reviewed as space allows after that date. Class size is limited to 30 students, so it is recommended that you apply early. Application fees will be waived.

Financing Your Education

Le Moyne College financial aid is available for this program. Be sure to fill out your FAFSA as early as possible in the calendar year you wish to start the program. Limited scholarship monies are available. Stafford loan monies are available to independent students, if they do not qualify for other need-based aid or employer tuition

reimbursement programs. Students will pay a special part-time tuition charge for the first three years of the program. Full-time tuition will be charged for the final semester. A monthly tuition payment plan is available.

Employment Opportunities

Both education and human services are experiencing tremendous growth in job openings. The state Department of Labor projections for educators and social service workers (and managers) are very favorable for the Central New York region. The Human Service sector is rated as a top ten industry for Cayuga County. Average annual salaries for teachers and social service workers/managers, as estimated by the New York State Department of Labor, range between \$33,000 to \$63,000.
