Read&Write

Read&Write is a literacy support tool that offers help with reading text out loud and other features.

Install Desktop Version:

- o Go to: https://www.texthelp.com/products/read-and-write-education/
- Scroll down and select Try Read&Write
- Select computer type (Windows or Mac)
- o Read&Write.exe will download. Open and click Accept and Install
- o After installing, Read&Write should be available on the Desktop

How to use:

- Open Read&Write on the Desktop
- If prompted, sign in with Microsoft using your Cayuga email address and password
- A tool bar should appear at the top of the screen
- On the computer, open the document:
 - > If it's a **Word** doc, open it in Word
 - > If it's a **PDF**, open the PDF
 - > If it's a webpage, please use Read&Write's Google Chrome Extension (see below)
- With the mouse, highlight the text and click Play ► in the toolbar
- Go to settings in the toolbar to change the voice or the speed

Install Google Chrome Extension: Compatible with



- o Using Google Chrome, go to: Read&Write for Google Chrome
- Click on Add to Chrome
- Select the Add extension option in the pop-up window
- Under extensions in the top right corner, click on the icon
- $\circ\hspace{0.1in}$ If prompted, sign into email account to complete activation

How to use:

- Using Google Chrome, navigate to Brightspace (or any webpage)
- Click on the icon extensions in the top right corner
- The **Read&Write** toolbar will appear at the top of the browser
- Highlight text on the webpage and click Play
- To change the settings (voice, speed, etc.), click on ... and select **Options**

To read PDFs from Google Drive using Read&Write for Google Chrome:

- Open a PDF in Google Drive and click "Open with"
- Select Read&Write for Google Chrome
- If prompted, continue to **OrbitNote** and sign into an email account
- The PDF will open with the **Read&Write** toolbar at the top.
- Highlight text in the PDF and click Play



EquatIO

Equation writer to create accessible digital Math. Take a screenshot of the equation with EquatIO's Screenshot Reader to convert it into accessible math, which will read the equation aloud.





- o Go to: https://www.texthelp.com/products/equatio/
- o Scroll down and select Try EquatIO
- Select computer type (Windows or Mac)
- o EquatiO.exe will download. Open and click Accept and Install
- o After installing, **EquatiO** should be available on the Desktop

How to use Screenshot Reader:

- Open **EquatIO** on the Desktop
- If prompted, sign in with Microsoft using Cayuga email address and password
- A tool bar should appear at the bottom of the screen
- On the computer, open the math document
 - > If it's a webpage, navigate to the site
 - > If it's a Word doc, open it in Word
 - > If it's a **PDF**, open the PDF, etc.
- Select EquatIO's Screenshot Reader in the toolbar



- Drag a box around the equation using the mouse
- The equation will be converted into accessible math and read aloud
