(submitted directly from your school)
- Emerson Application/Personal Essay
- One Letter of Recommendation
(from teacher, counselor or employer)
- Current resume that details outstanding community involvement, leadership, service or commitment to employment
- Completed FAFSA
(Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

- Completed TAP Application
(Tuition Assistance Program)
Cayuga's TAP Code: 2005
