

FREE Text-To-Speech Programs

Step-by-step directions on how to install and use free text-to-speech software.



Read&Write

Program that reads text aloud.

Visit [R&W Quick Reference Guides](#) for information about additional features.

Install Read&Write Desktop Version:

For Windows:

- Go to: [Read&Write for Windows](#) to download **R&W.exe** file
- Once downloaded, find R&W.exe file (Downloads) and double-click to start the installer
- Click **Accept and Install**

For MacOS:

- Go to: [Read&Write for MacOS](#) to download **R&W.dmg** file
- Drag the Read&Write icon to the Applications folder
- Follow prompts and agree to permissions (click Allow or OK)

How to use:

- Open Read&Write
- When prompted, sign in with **Microsoft** using your **Cayuga email** and **password**
- A tool bar should appear at the top of the screen
- Open PDF, Word doc, etc. *For webpages use R&W's Browser Extension (see below)*
- With the mouse, highlight the text and click **Play** ► in the toolbar
- Go to settings in the toolbar to change the voice or the speed



Install Read&Write Browser Extension, Compatible with Brightspace:

Choose your preferred browser, Microsoft Edge or Google Chrome. Recommended browser is Google Chrome.



Install on Microsoft Edge

Open Edge browser and go to [R&W for Microsoft Edge](#). Click **Get**

- Select the **Add extension** option in the pop-up window
- Select  extensions in the top right corner and  pin Read&Write to the browser

Activate:

- Using Edge, navigate to Brightspace (or any webpage)
- Click on the R&W icon in the top right corner
- When prompted, sign into Microsoft and use Cayuga email and password



Install on Google Chrome

Open Chrome browser and to go [R&W for Google Chrome](#). Click **Add to Chrome**

- Select the **Add extension** option in the pop-up window
- Select  extensions in the top right corner and  pin Read&Write to the browser

Activate:

- Using Chrome, navigate to Brightspace (or any webpage)
- Click on the R&W icon in the top right corner
- When prompted, sign into Gmail account. Accept permissions.
- A toolbar will appear at the top of the browser
- Select ... in the right-hand corner of the toolbar
- Go to Settings > Accounts
- **Sign in with Microsoft** and use Cayuga email and password to complete activation

How to use the Browser Extension:

- Click on the R&W icon in the top right corner of the browser
- A toolbar will appear at the top of the browser
- Highlight text on the screen and click Play
- To change the settings (voice, speed, etc.), click on ... and select **Options**

Equatio

Use Equatio's Screenshot Reader to have **MATH** equations read aloud.

Install Equatio Desktop Version

Compatible with  Brightspace &  Pearson MyLab & Mastering:

- Go to: [Download Equatio](#)
- Select Windows or Mac
- **Equatio** file will download. Open and click **Accept and Install**
- Or follow prompts and agree to permissions (click Allow or OK)
- After installing, an **Equatio** icon should be available on the Desktop or in Applications

How to use Screenshot Reader:

- Open **Equatio**
- When prompted, sign in with **Microsoft** using your **Cayuga** email and password
- A tool bar should appear at the bottom of the screen
- Open a math document, or navigate to Brightspace or Pearson, etc.
- Select Equatio's **Screenshot Reader** in the toolbar
- Drag a box around the equation using the mouse
- The equation will be converted into readable math. Click the play button
- To change the settings (voice, speed, etc.), click Equatio on the toolbar and select Options

 **Install Equatio Browser Extension**, Compatible with  Brightspace &  Pearson:

Choose your preferred browser, Microsoft Edge or Google Chrome. Recommended browser is Google Chrome.

Install on **Microsoft Edge**

Open Edge browser and go to [Equatio for Edge](#). Click **Get Extension** at the top of the page

- Select the **Add extension** option in the pop-up window
- Select  extensions in the top right corner and  pin Equatio to the browser

Install on **Google Chrome**

Open Chrome browser and go to [Equatio for Chrome](#). Click **Add to Chrome**

- Select the **Add extension** option in the pop-up window
- Select  extensions in the top right corner and  pin Equatio to the browser

Activate:

- Click on the Equatio icon in the top right corner of the browser
- When prompted, sign in with **Microsoft** using your **Cayuga email** and **password**
- A toolbar will appear at the bottom of the browser

How to use the Browser Extension

- Select Equatio's  **Screenshot Reader** in the toolbar
- Drag a box around the equation using the mouse
- The equation will be converted into readable math. Click the play button
- To change the settings (voice, speed, etc.), click Equatio on the toolbar and select Options

Natural Reader

Software with natural-sounding voices that converts text into spoken words.

 **Install Natural Reader Browser Extension**, Compatible with  Brightspace

Choose your preferred browser, Microsoft Edge or Google Chrome. Recommended browser is Google Chrome.



Install on **Microsoft Edge**

Open Edge browser and go to [NaturalReader for Edge](#) . Click **Get Extension** at the top of the page

- Select the **Add extension** option in the pop-up window
- Select  extensions in the top right corner and  pin NaturalReader to the browser



Install on **Google Chrome**

Open Chrome browser and go to [NaturalReader for Chrome](#). Click **Add to Chrome**

- Select the **Add extension** option in the pop-up window
- Select  extensions in the top right corner and  pin Read&Write to the browser

How to use:

- Navigate to Brightspace or any webpage
- Click on the  icon in the top right corner of the browser
- The Natural Reader toolbar will appear
- **Highlight** text on the screen and click the Play  button
- Click on the face icon to change the voice or speed

Natural Reader Mobile App (iOS or Android):

- Take a picture of the QR Code with your mobile phone



- Install Natural Reader from the app store
- Open app on phone and create an account
- Select **Camera** to take a picture of document, textbook, computer screen, etc.
- Select **Use Photo** and then click the play button
- Or select **ADD** to upload a file stored on your phone

Natural Reader Web & Desktop Version:

- Go to: <https://www.naturalreaders.com/>
- Select Get Started > Personal
- Web Reader will open up
- Select **Upload Document**
- Choose: PDF or file, Images, or Webpage URL
- Or drag and drop files right into the Natural Reader window
- To create an account and access from your Desktop: Select **Account > Login > Sign up**
- Natural Reader icon will now be available on Desktop



Read Aloud

Read Aloud uses text-to-speech technology to convert webpage text to audio.

If your preferred browser is Mozilla Firefox:

Install  Read Aloud Extension for  Firefox, Compatible with  Brightspace:

- Open **Firefox** browser and go to: [Mozilla Add Ons](https://addons.mozilla.org/)
- Enter **Read Aloud** in the **Find add-ons** search bar
- Select Read Aloud and Click **Add to Firefox**
- A box will pop up - “Add Read Aloud: A Text to Speech Voice Reader?” Click **Add**
- A box will pop up - “Read Aloud” was added. Click **Okay**
- The Read Aloud icon will appear in the top right-hand corner of the Firefox menu

How to use:

- Navigate to the webpage using Firefox
- **Highlight** text on the page and **right click the mouse**
- Scroll down through the options box and select **Read aloud selected text**



Acrobat Reader

Open and interact with PDF files – includes a built-in PDF reader.

Install Acrobat Reader:

- Go to <https://get.adobe.com/reader/>
- Click on **Download Acrobat Reader**
- Open the download folder and locate the **Adobe Acrobat Installer** file
- Double-click on the installer to complete installation
- Acrobat Reader should be available on the Desktop

How to use built-in PDF reader:

- Open Acrobat Reader on the Desktop. Locate and open PDF saved on computer
- Click on **View** from the top left menu
- Scroll down to **Read Out Loud** and select **Activate Read Out Loud**
- Click text on the screen with the mouse
- To Turn **off**: Go to **View > Read Out Loud > Deactivate Reader, Pause, or Stop**
