

# FREE Text-To-Speech Programs

Step by step directions on how to install and use free text-to-speech programs.



## Read&Write

*A literacy support tool that can read text out loud with additional features.*

### Install DESKTOP Version:

- Go to: <https://www.texthelp.com/products/read-and-write-education/>
- Scroll down and select **Try Read&Write**
- Select **“Start your trial today”** (This will NOT be a trial. This will be the full version!)
- Choose **“I am... A Student”** and enter a reason in the **“Tell us why...”** box
- Click **Start your Free Trial**
- Select computer type (Windows or Mac)
- **Read&Write.exe** will download. Open and click **Accept and Install**
- After installing, a Read&Write icon should be available on the Desktop



### How to use:

- Open **Read&Write** on the Desktop
- When prompted, sign in with **Microsoft** using your **Cayuga** email and password
- A tool bar should appear at the top of the screen
- On the computer, open the document:
  - If it's a **Word** doc, open it in Word
  - If it's a **PDF**, open the PDF
  - If it's a **webpage**, please use Read&Write's **Google Chrome Extension** (*see below*)
- With the mouse, highlight the text and click **Play** ► in the toolbar
- Go to settings in the toolbar to change the voice or the speed

## Install Read&Write Google Chrome Extension, Compatible with Brightspace

- Using **Google Chrome**, go to: [Chrome Web Store-Read&Write for Google Chrome](#)
- Click on **Add to Chrome**
- Select the **Add extension** option in the pop-up window
- Select  extensions in the top right corner and  pin Read&Write to the browser

## How to use:

- Using Google Chrome, navigate to Brightspace (or any webpage!)
- Click on the  icon in the top right corner
- When prompted, sign into Gmail account to complete activation
- The **Read&Write** toolbar will appear at the top of the browser
- Highlight any text on the webpage and click Play ►
- To change the settings (voice, speed, etc.), click on ... and select **Options**

To read PDFs from  Google Drive using  **Read&Write** for  **Google Chrome**:

- Open a PDF in Google Drive and click “Open with”
- Select Read&Write for Google Chrome
- If prompted, continue to **OrbitNote** and sign into Gmail account
- The PDF will open with the **Read&Write** toolbar at the top.
- Highlight text in the PDF and click Play ►



## Equatio

*Equation writer to create digital Math. Use the Screenshot Reader to have equations read aloud.*

**Install DESKTOP Version**, Compatible with  **Brightspace** &  **Pearson MyLab & Mastering**

- Go to: <https://www.texthelp.com/products/equatio/>
- Scroll down and select **Try Equatio**
- Select **“Start your trial today”** (This will NOT be a trial. This will be the full version!)
- Choose **“I am... A Student”** and enter a reason in the **“Tell us why...”** box
- Click **Start your Free Trial**
- Select computer type (Windows or Mac)
- **Equatio.exe** will download. Open and click **“Accept and Install”**
- After installing, an **Equatio** icon should be available on the Desktop



## How to use Screenshot Reader:

- Open **Equatio** on the Desktop
- When prompted, sign in with **Microsoft** using your **Cayuga** email and password
- A tool bar should appear at the bottom of the screen
- On the computer, open the math document
  - If it's a **webpage**, navigate to the site

- If it's a **Word** doc, open it in Word
- If it's a **PDF**, open the PDF, etc.
- Select Equatio's Screenshot Reader in the toolbar
- Drag a box around the equation using the mouse
- The equation will be converted into readable math. Click the play button
