Once you have submitted the transcripts to the Student Financial Services Office a review of your unusual enrollment history will be conducted and you will be notified of the determination.

If your transcript(s) fail to show sufficient earned credit hours you will need to:

- Provide a written explanation of why you were not able to earn credit hours and the reason you have attended multiple colleges during the past several years. Third party documentation may be required to support your claims.

Once the above information has been received, the Student Financial Services Office will review your application and you will be notified of your federal aid eligibility. Failure to submit the required documents may lead to loss of all federal aid.
