

Financial Aid Procedures

CCC State Code – 2005

TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID ONLINE:

- Apply for an **FSA ID** for you & a FSA ID for your parent, if you are a dependent student, at studentaid.gov.
- Complete the **2026-2027 FAFSA** online at studentaid.gov using 2024 tax information. CCC's federal school code is 002861. FAFSA will send you an email notification once your application is processed. To check on the status of your completed FAFSA go to the studentaid.gov website or contact the Student Financial Services Office at (315) 294-8470.
- Once you have completed the FAFSA, follow the link and complete the online state **TAP** application. To be eligible to receive a TAP Grant, students must be a New York State resident, be financially eligible, be in at least 3 TAP eligible credits, have all official transcripts on file, AND HAVE COMPLETED THE TAP APPLICATION. If you miss the direct link to the TAP website you can apply directly at hesc.ny.gov approximately 2 days after your FAFSA information has been processed. CCC's TAP code is 2005.
- Students who are New York State residents can also apply for the Excelsior Scholarship by visiting hesc.ny.gov. This scholarship has other criteria that must be met in order to be determined eligible.

Applications filed less than two weeks before classes begin are not guaranteed to be processed in time to be used as a deferral towards the tuition bill. Students who apply after this time will need to be prepared to make payment to the Student Financial Services Office to hold their registration.

TO ACCEPT A STUDENT LOAN IN YOUR MYCAYUGA ACCOUNT:

Go to cayuga-cc.edu and click on myCayuga, select LOGIN:

Click on Student Dashboard

Click on Financial Aid

Click Offer at top of screen, this will display your financial aid awards

Click Take Action

If you are accepting the full loan amounts: select Accept for each loan you want to accept and click Submit OR if you want to accept a lower loan amount than what is offered: select Modify and enter the amount you are requesting in the box to the right and click Submit.

Fall / Spring students - any amount accepted will be disbursed half during the fall semester and half during the spring semester.

TO COMPLETE THE STUDENT LOAN PROCESS STUDENTS MUST:

Complete Entrance Counseling online using your FSA ID, email or mobile phone at studentaid.gov.

Sign a Master Promissory Note online using your FSA ID, email or mobile phone at: studentaid.gov.

FINANCIAL AID WILL BE DISBURSED BASED ON CLASSES THAT HAVE ALREADY BEGUN!

Financial Aid awards will begin disbursing approximately six weeks after the start of the semester.

This includes all student loans. Refunds will be paid out based on the number of credits you are attending that have already begun and that apply to your degree.


Additional disbursement *may* be made after you have begun attending late start classes.

Student loans will be disbursed after you have begun attendance in 6 credits.

My Financial Aid CHECKLIST



Check myCayuga account weekly

- CCC sends all official communications electronically to your myCayuga email account.
- Access your myCayuga account by visiting the Cayuga Community College website at cayuga-cc.edu. At the top of the page, click on myCayuga.
- If you need assistance with your myCayuga account, contact the Help Desk at 315-501-1993 or email helpdesk@cayuga-cc.edu.



Accept a Student Employment Award

- Accept or decline your Federal Work Study award via myCayuga.
- After you have accepted your award, you will receive an email with additional information and a link to the Student Employment application. Complete and submit to Student Financial Services. You will be contacted for placement. Jobs are not guaranteed and are first come first served.



Confirmation of Charges

- All students are required to complete Confirmation of Charges every semester via myCayuga.
- Failure to confirm may result in all courses being deregistered, whether or not your semester bill is satisfied. If you are deregistered, you may re-register but course availability varies.
- Confirming charges acknowledges the student was presented with and reviewed financial aid, billing, and refund policies.



TAP (Tuition Assistance Program)

New York state residents only

- Apply for TAP via FAFSA or TAP online.
- Your financial aid offer may have included an **estimated** TAP award based on income on the FAFSA.
- After New York State Higher Education Services Corporation (HESC) verifies all information, the TAP award is confirmed and the College is notified. The amount may be different from the **estimated** TAP award in your financial aid offer.
- If you received a TAP award while attending another school, you must submit an official transcript to CCC's Registrars Office.
- If you have questions regarding TAP, visit hesc.ny.gov for more information.
- Note: CCC's TAP school code is 2005.



Submit your final high school transcript

- All students must submit a **FINAL** high school transcript (or original GED or equivalent diploma). Please contact CCC's Admissions Office with specific questions.
- Financial aid recipients must have a transcript on file for funds to credit the bill and/or generate a refund (if applicable).



Excelsior Scholarship

New York state residents only

- Students who are New York State residents can also apply for the Excelsior Scholarship by visiting hesc.ny.gov. This scholarship has other criteria that must be met in order to be determined eligible.



Obtain Certificate of Residence

- **To avoid double tuition charges**, students who have been New York State residents for at least 12 months, but are not residents of Cayuga County must submit a Certificate of Residency Form.
