

Wireless access instructions OpenCayuga (Auburn Campus Only)

Windows XP

To set up your Windows XP or Windows 2000 laptop to access the OpenCayuga wireless network:


1. Double-click the Wireless icon usually located in the bottom right hand corner of your screen.
2. The Wireless Network Connection window displays for you to choose a wireless network. It will look something like the picture below. It should say “**OpenCayuga**” as the SSID name:



3. You may see several SSID's in the list. Select “**OpenCayuga**” from the list then select the **Connect** button.
4. A warning dialog may display the message: "You are connecting to an unsecured network." Select the **Connect Anyway** button as shown below:



5. Close the **Choose a wireless network** window by selecting the red X in the upper right-hand corner.
6. Open a web browser, for example, Internet Explorer or Mozilla Firefox. You may now navigate on the Internet freely.

Windows Vista and Windows 7

To set up your Windows Vista or Windows 7 laptop to access the OpenCayuga wireless network:


1. Double-click the Wireless icon usually located in the bottom right hand corner of your screen.




2. The **Wireless networks are available** window displays and indicates that you are Not Currently Connected to a wireless network.
3. Select **Connect to a network**:



4. The Connect to a Network dialog displays:




5. You may see several SSID's in the list. Select "**OpenCayuga**" from the list of available SSID's and then select the **Connect** button.
6. A warning dialog window displays the message "**OpenCayuga**" is an unsecured network:



7. Select the **Connect Anyway** option
8. The Connect to a network window displays the message **successfully connected**.

9. If asked to save the network for future use select the **Save this Network** check box then select the **Close** button. This will allow you to connect to the network automatically the next time you visit Cayuga Community College.
10. The Set Network Location window displays:



11. Select the **Public Location** option.
12. Open a web browser, for example, Internet Explorer or Mozilla Firefox. You may now navigate on the Internet freely.




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Macintosh OS X 10.3 – 10.6

To set up your Apple Macintosh laptop to access the OpenCayuga wireless network:

1. Select the Airport icon on your Menu Bar at the top right-corner of your screen.
2. Select “**OpenCayuga**” from the list of available SSID’s:



3. Open a web browser, for example, Safari or Mozilla Firefox. You may now navigate on the Internet freely.
