
BASIC ESSAY STRUCTURE

An essay develops one main idea in logical, well-developed paragraphs. This is one method of structuring an essay. Notice that the structure here is very similar to the structure of a paragraph.



<u>Essay</u>

- 1. One main idea developed in a number of paragraphs
- 2. A logical pattern of organization
- 3. And introductory paragraph ending with a thesis
- 4. Body paragraphs developing the main idea
- 5. A concluding paragraph

Paragraph

- 1. One main idea developed in about 4-8 sentences
- 2. A logical pattern of organization
- 3. A topic sentence opening the paragraph
- 4. Middle sentences developing the main idea
- 5. A concluding sentence
